



## Youth Art Design Contest

### STUDENT GUIDELINES

**Open to students in grades K-6**

- 🍓 All participating students must be enrolled in grades **K-6**.
- 🍓 Art must be submitted on **8 ½ x 11** paper.
- 🍓 **(ENTRIES THAT DO NOT CONFORM TO THESE SPECIFICATIONS WILL NOT BE JUDGED AND DO NOT RECEIVE PARTICIPATING BENEFITS)**
- 🍓 Artwork must be drawn free hand by the student and depict something about strawberries or the California Strawberry Festival.
- 🍓 **DO NOT USE CHALK – DO NOT LAMINATE or PLACE ON CARDBOARD**
- 🍓 Only one art entry per student.

### TEACHERS' RESPONSIBILITIES

- 🍓 Must turn in an **ENTRY FORM**. Submit to address is listed on Entry Form.
- 🍓 Name of Student, School Name, School District, Grade and Teacher's name **MUST BE PRINTED legibly** on back of each art entry. **ENTRIES WITHOUT THIS INFORMATION WILL NOT BE JUDGED.**
- 🍓 Teachers are responsible for turning in a complete **PRINTED LIST** of all their participating students. Distribution of tickets will be based on the list. The CSF does not provide a copy of list with tickets. Teachers must keep a copy for their records.
- 🍓 All participants and participating teachers will receive one free admission ticket or complimentary pass to the Festival.
- 🍓 **Teachers will be responsible for the pick-up of tickets at the Festival office in March and April and distribution of these tickets to their students. Any tickets not picked up by April 30, 2020 will be returned to stock and no longer available to the students.**
- 🍓 **CSF WILL NOT MAIL OUT TICKETS.**

A special committee of the California Strawberry Festival will judge all entries.

*The chosen winner will receive a \$100 gift card to the Lakeshore Learning Store, tickets to the Festival, t-shirt with their artwork screen printed, and take part in the unveiling ceremony. The winning youth's teacher will receive a \$50 gift card to the Lakeshore Learning Store, two tickets to the Festival, a t-shirt with the winning artwork screen printed and take part in the artwork unveiling ceremony.*

Winner and runners-up artwork may be on display after the unveiling date at a location to be determined at a later date. All entries may be displayed at Festival. Entries displayed may be returned to the student after the Festival. Winner will be announced in a special unveiling during the month of March or April.
